Past Simple

# Past Simple

- I worked there.
- We invited them.
- She passed the exam.
- They wrote letters.
- You went there.

# Past Simple negative

- I **did not** work there.
- We **didn't** invite them.
- She **didn't** pass the exam.
- They **did not** write letters.
- You **did not** go there.

# Past Simple questions

- I **worked** there. **Did** you **work** there?
- We **invited** them. **Did** you **invite** them?
- She **passed** the exam. **Did** she **pass** it?
- They **wrote** letters. **Did** they **write** letters?
- You **went** there. **Did** you **go** there?

# Past Simple (to be)

- I **was**
- You **were**
- He/She/It **was**
- We **were**
- They **were**

# Past Simple (to be) negative

- I **was not**
- You **were not**
- He/She/It **wasn't**
- We **weren't**
- They **were not**



# Past Simple (to be) question

- **Was** the weather good?
- **Were** you absent yesterday?
- **Were** they here last month?
